INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS

(8.12) million for the quarter and nine months period ended December 31, 2024 respectively, as considered in the Statement, in respect of 3 joint ventures, whose interim financial statements / financial information/ financial results have not been reviewed by us.
